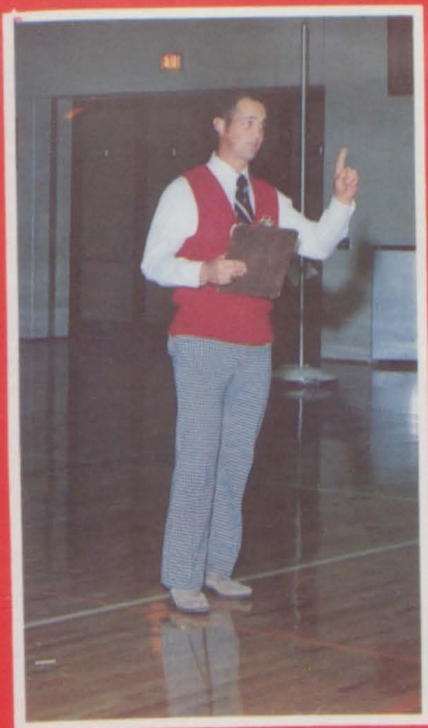
Dance Highlights Homecoming

Mike Cisler and Keith Späude were awarded the Most-Valuable Players Awards. Dale Raymaker was named the most-improved player.



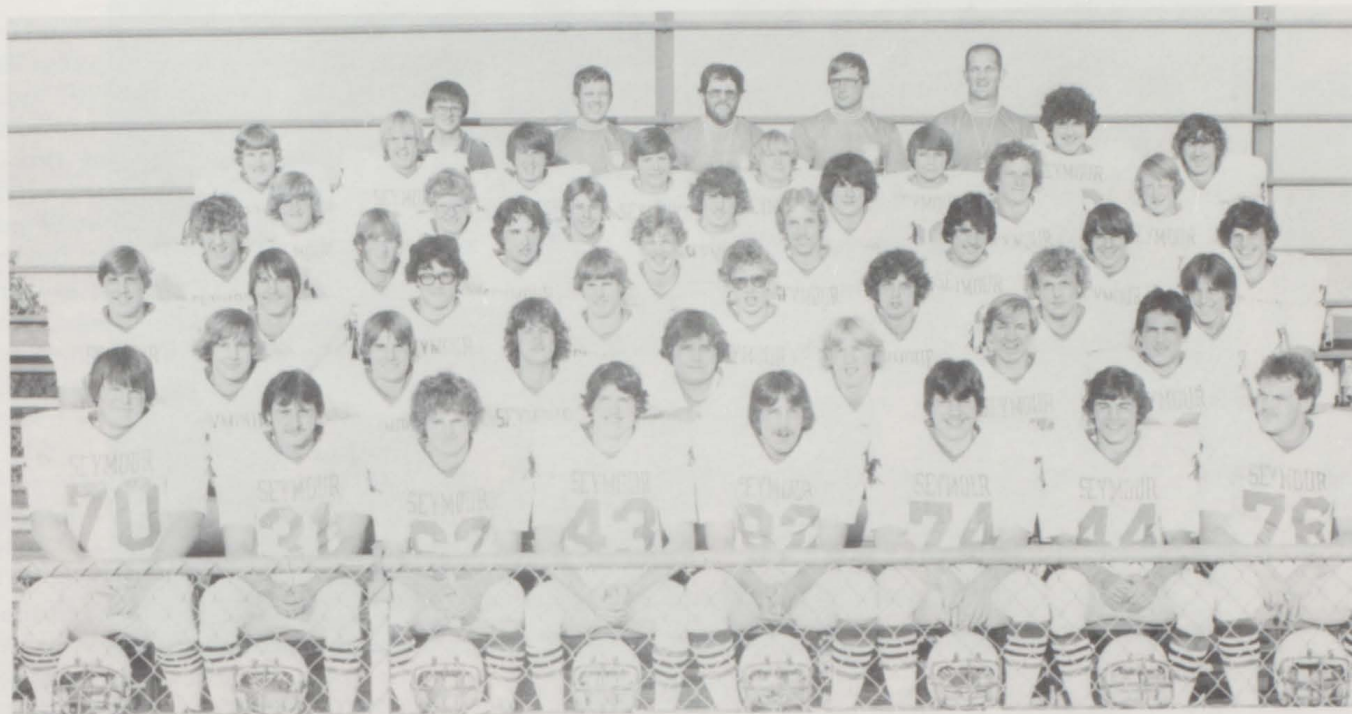

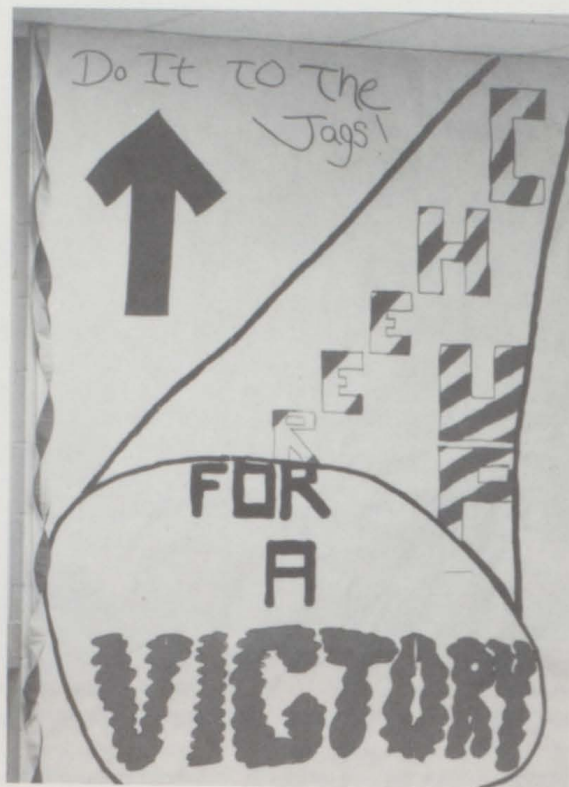

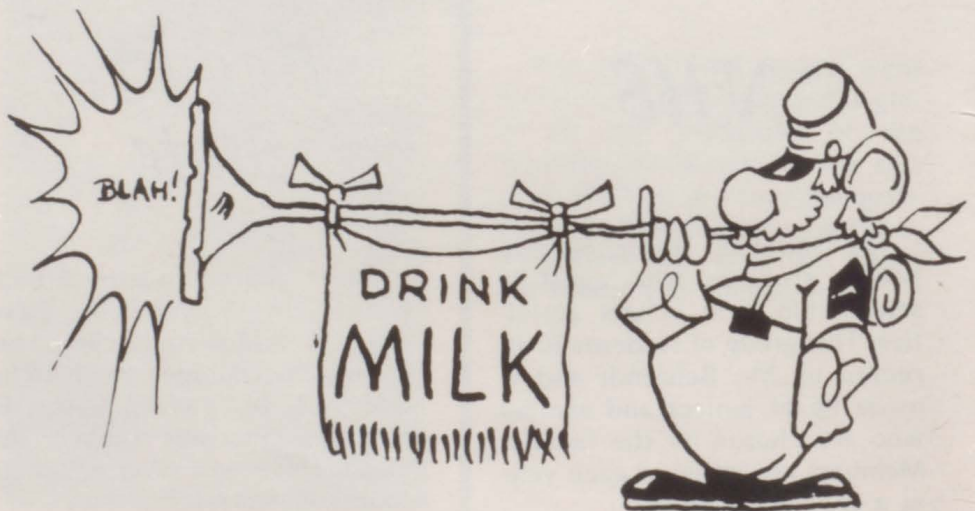
