## A NIGHT TO REMEMBER



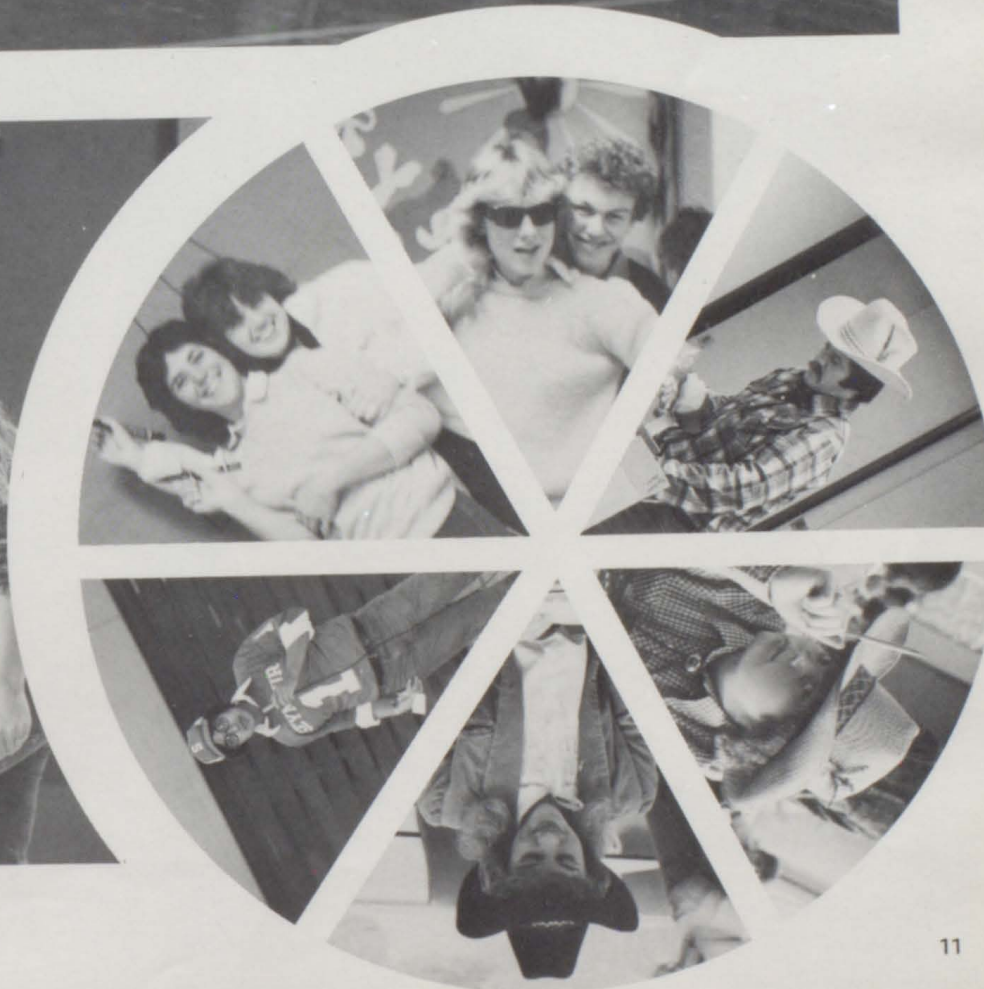

Commons decorating was held Tuesday evening. S-club won the best overall and club mural competition. Best class mural was won by the Class of 1983.



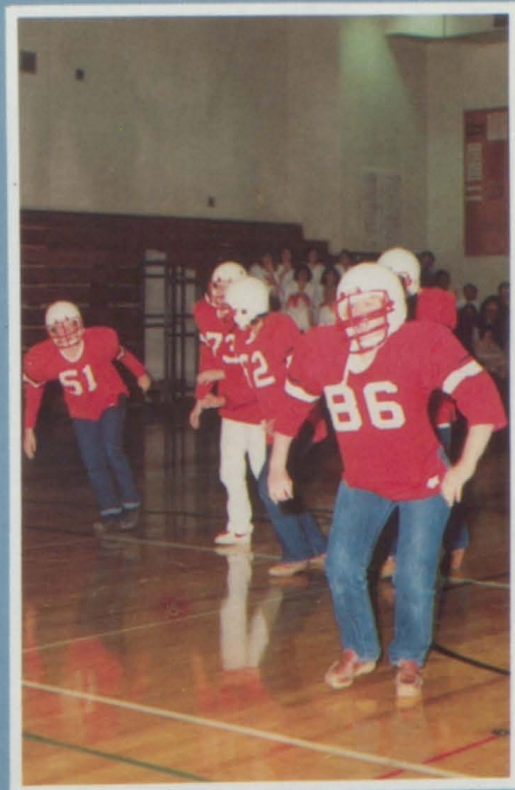
# HOMECOMING "UPS" SCHOOL SPIRIT

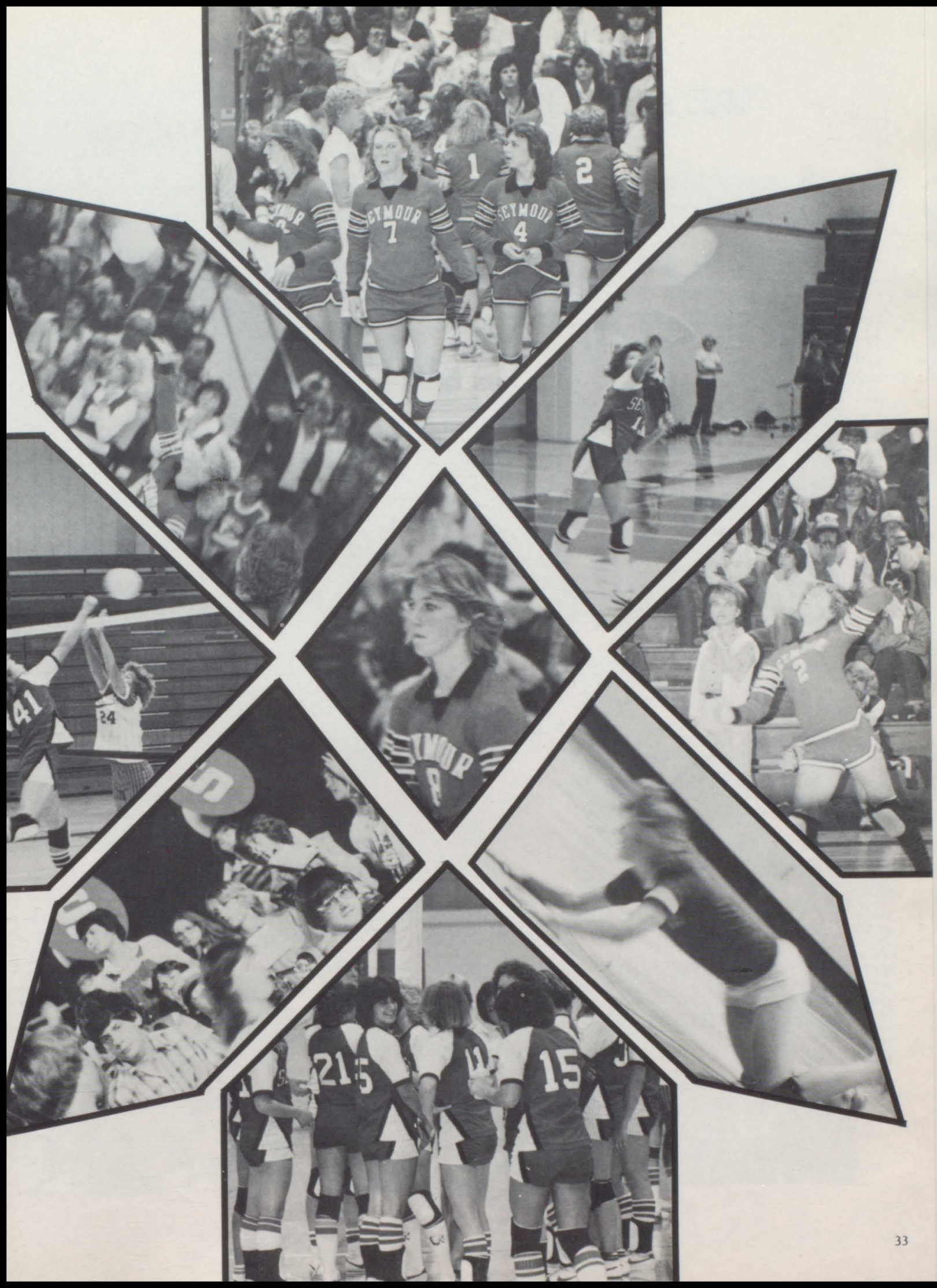

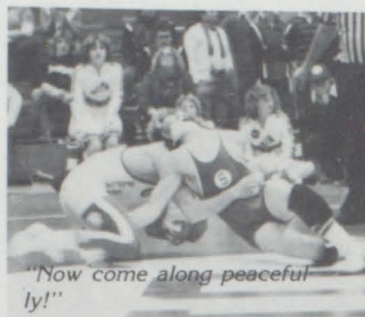
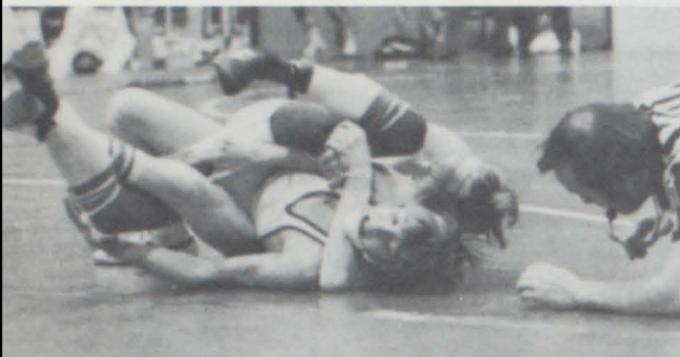
The Seymour Indians had a disappointing season this year with a 1-8 record. They played hard but often found themselves losing by only a few points.
