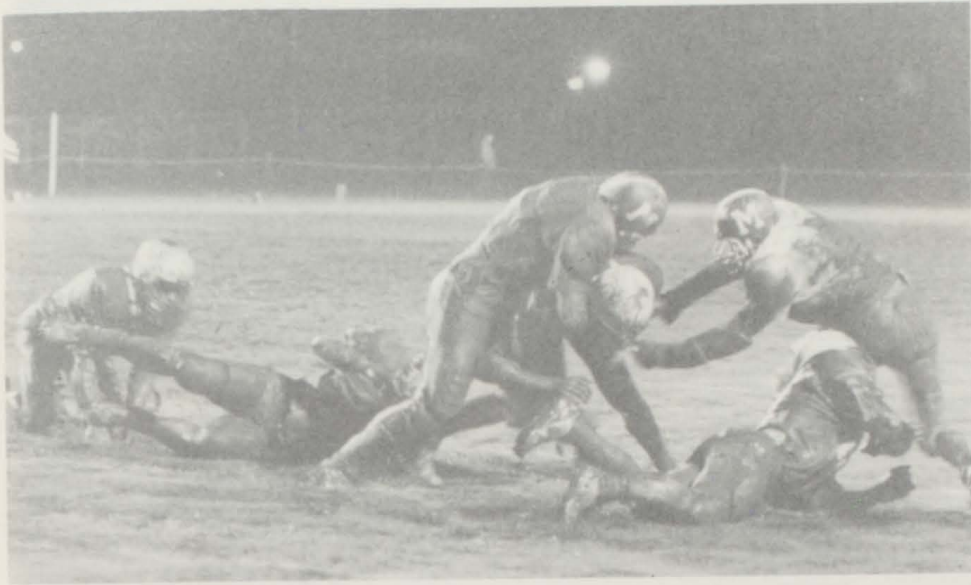


HOMECOMING 1986

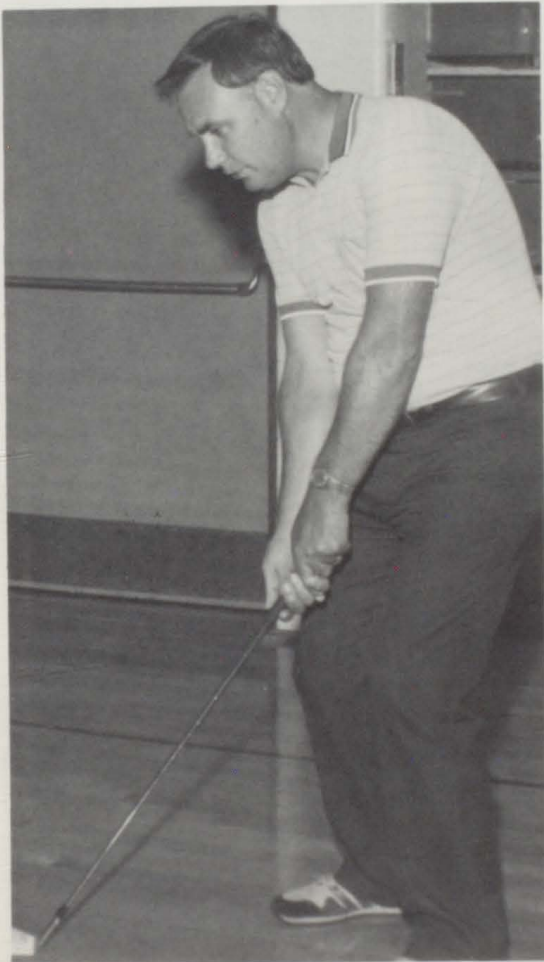

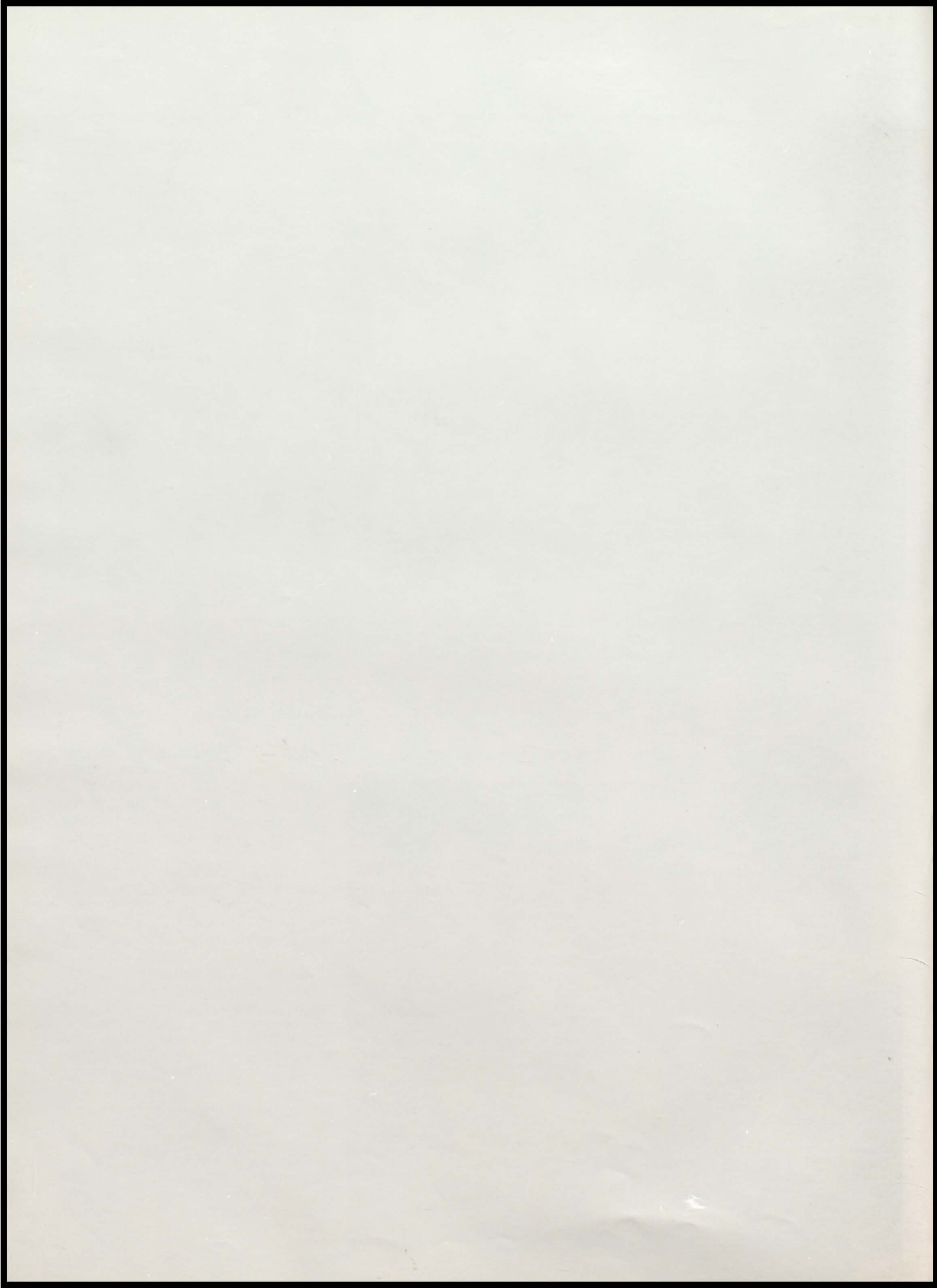
Student Council is an elected group of students who represent the student body. They plan activities to better improve the school and the community. They also try to solve problems that arise during the school year.

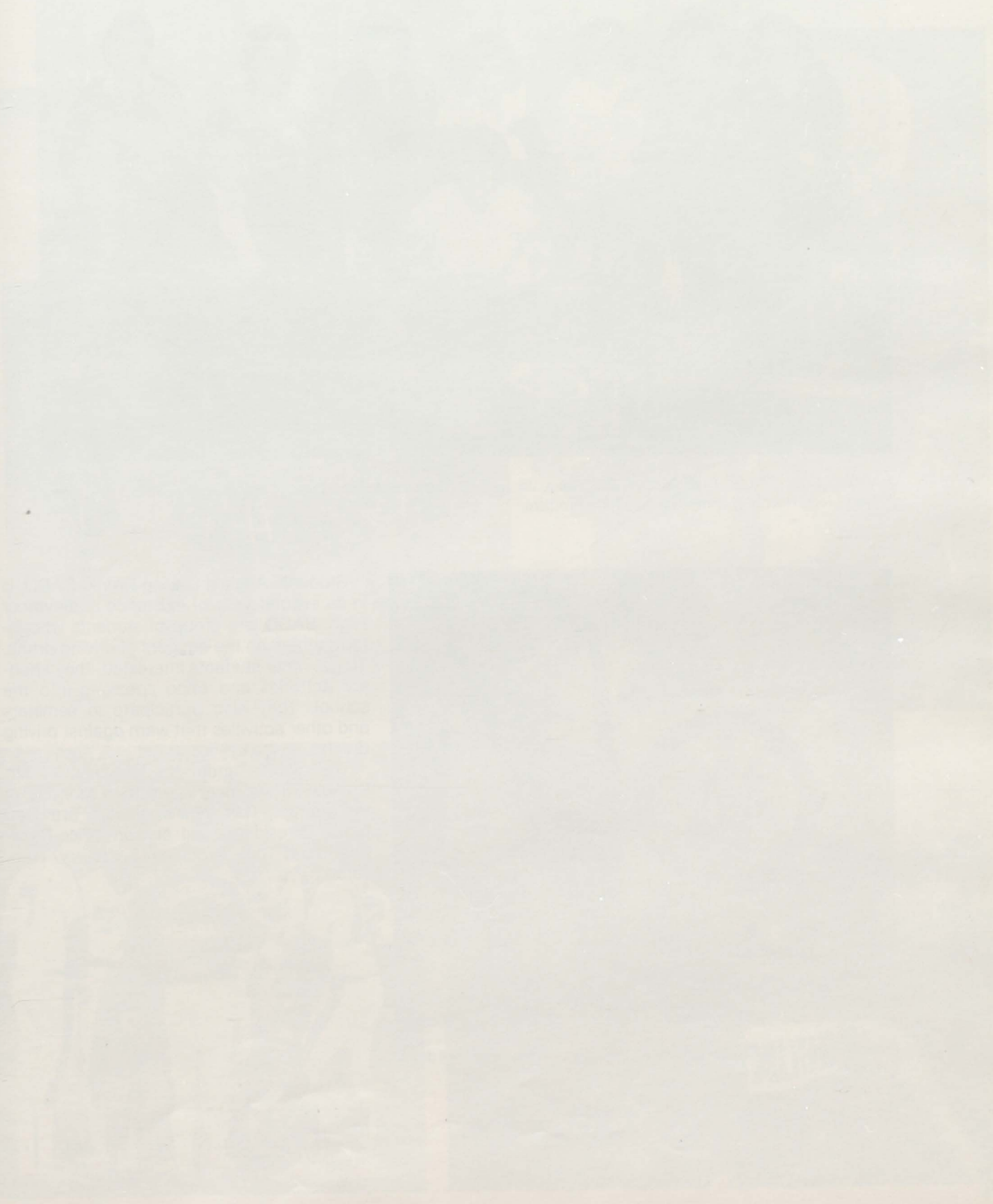
Chapters are recognized and awarded at the state convention in Green Lake and the national convention in Kansas City for outstanding FFA programs.
