May 2, 1992



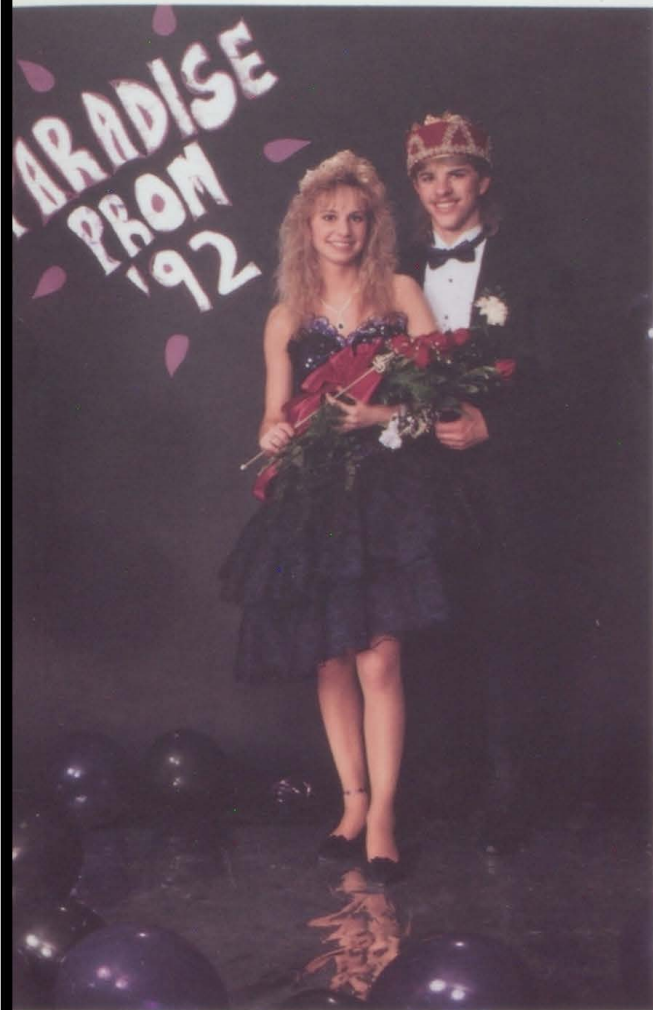

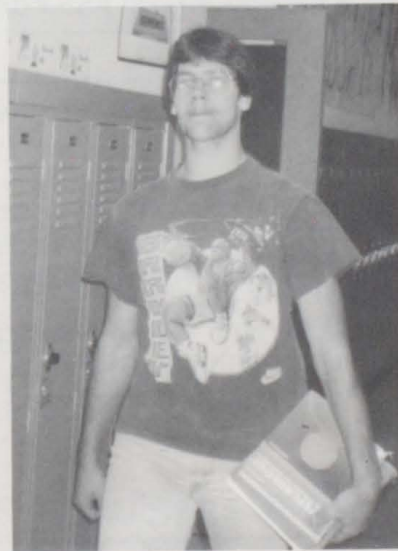
The Golf season started out with the largest turn out of athletes in history (21) and ended with 16. Most of these golfers were sophomores.
