

4K Areas of Emphasis

The 4K Seymour Community School District 4K program is based on the Wisconsin Model of Early Learning Standards (WMELS).

The 4K curriculum is developmentally appropriate with play-based instruction in the following five domains:

Language Development and Communication

Children learn to use language to convey meaning. They learn early concepts of print and develop awareness that letters are visual graphics. They also learn to use more complex vocabulary and sentence structure.

Approaches to Learning

Children will learn to hold and manipulate tools to create things of their own design. They will participate in rhythmic and creative movement and use medium for tactile experiences and exploration.

Cognition and General Knowledge

Children will observe and make discoveries. They will apply information or experience to new context. They will learn to classify and show awareness of cause and effect and experience other activities that will help them build a learning foundation.

Health and Physical Development

Children will demonstrate an awareness of their bodies in space, use balance and control to perform large motor tasks. They will use strength and control to perform fine motor tasks, and manipulate and explore a variety of sensory materials.

Social and Emotional Development

Children will learn to show confidence with self, family, and community. They will show self-control and learn to resolve conflict. They will demonstrate decision-making and problem-solving. They will participate in the group life of the class and learn to interact with adults in a variety of settings.
