Dear Seymour Community School District Parents and Guardians,

Living in our great state of Wisconsin allows us to have four great seasons to enjoy! Unfortunately it also provides us with some challenges over the winter months with travel and safely transporting students to school. This year we have had to delay or cancel school due to the inclement weather and this has created a situation in which we will not meet the required minutes per Wisconsin State Statutes.

In order to meet these required minutes, we will need to add 15 minutes to our school days starting Monday, April 30th. School will start at 7:55am and conclude at 3:10pm. The schedule for our 4K students will also be adjusted. The morning classes will begin at 7:55am and end at 11:16am. The afternoon classes will begin at 11:55am and end at 3:11pm. Bus routes will be adjusted accordingly!

Our 9th through 12th graders will also participate in a personalized learning day to make up 7 hours of instruction. This will be a two week window in which they need to complete an assignment for each of their classes. The specific information on this will be shared with all students and communicated to their parents by the high school administration.

While we realize this change in schedule will affect all families in a little different way, we really appreciate your understanding!
