You must include a QUOTE from the story and a specific example from the film to backup your statement. Why was this story element interesting, important, and powerful??? (AVOID saying things like it made it more interesting, etc. BE SPECIFIC about how this impacted the characterization.)
- In paragraph #2 discuss the difference you selected and explain HOW THE CHANGE IN THE MOVIE <u>ALTERED YOUR VIEW OF</u> <u>THE CHARACTERS.</u> Be specific about the difference including details from the movie and written text.
- 3. In paragraph #3 EVALUATE. Did you like the movie clip or the short story version better? Be **specific** about how the change impacted character or plot development. (If you say the movie was more visual you will get a ZERO for this question! All movies are more visual and literally show images where written texts describe them. The explanation needs to be SPECIFIC and **demonstrate the impact of the DECISIONS the director &/OR author made**)
