1. In paragraph #1 discuss the similarity you chose and **WHY IT WAS IMPORTANT FOR THE FILMMAKER TO KEEP THIS ELEMENT IN THE MOVIE.** You must include a QUOTE from the story and a specific example from the film to backup your statement. Why was this story element interesting, important, and powerful??? (**AVOID** saying things like it made it more interesting, etc. **BE SPECIFIC** about how this impacted the characterization.)
 2. In paragraph #2 discuss the difference you selected and **explain HOW THE CHANGE IN THE MOVIE ALTERED YOUR VIEW OF THE CHARACTERS.** Be specific about the difference including details from the movie and written text.
 3. In paragraph #3 **EVALUATE.** Did you like the movie clip or the short story version better? Be **specific** about how the change impacted character or plot development. (If you say the movie was more visual you will get a ZERO for this question! All movies are more visual and literally show images where written texts describe them. The explanation needs to be **SPECIFIC** and **demonstrate the impact of the DECISIONS the director &/OR author made**)
