Sample Intro for Prompt Listed Above:

George Orwell warned, "Absolute power corrupts absolutely." In his famous political allegory Orwell demonstrates just how true this statement is by showing leaders become corrupted because unleashed power. Squealer motivates with fear saying, "At least things are better than when Jones was here" (Orwell 52). However, readers are bombarded with examples of injustice, lies, and abuse under Napoleon's leadership and the incidents get progressively worse with the turning of each page. Clearly, despite Squealer's propaganda, Mr. Jones (although not perfect) was a better leader than Napoleon.
