The music was provided by the Vibratones, during which the couples could dance and enjoy the exquisite forests and gardens.



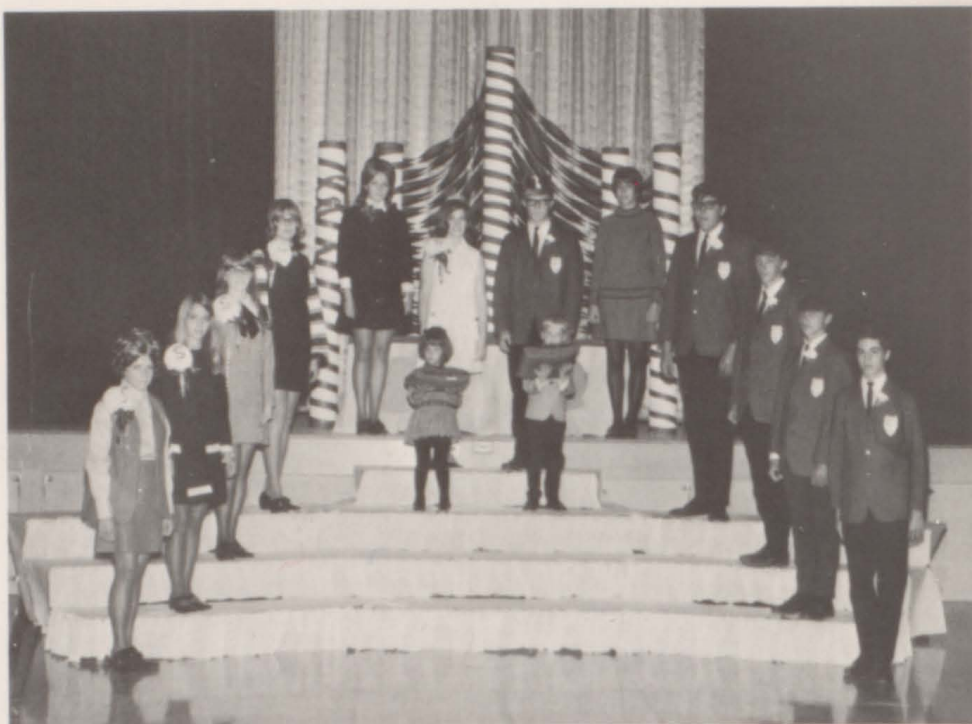

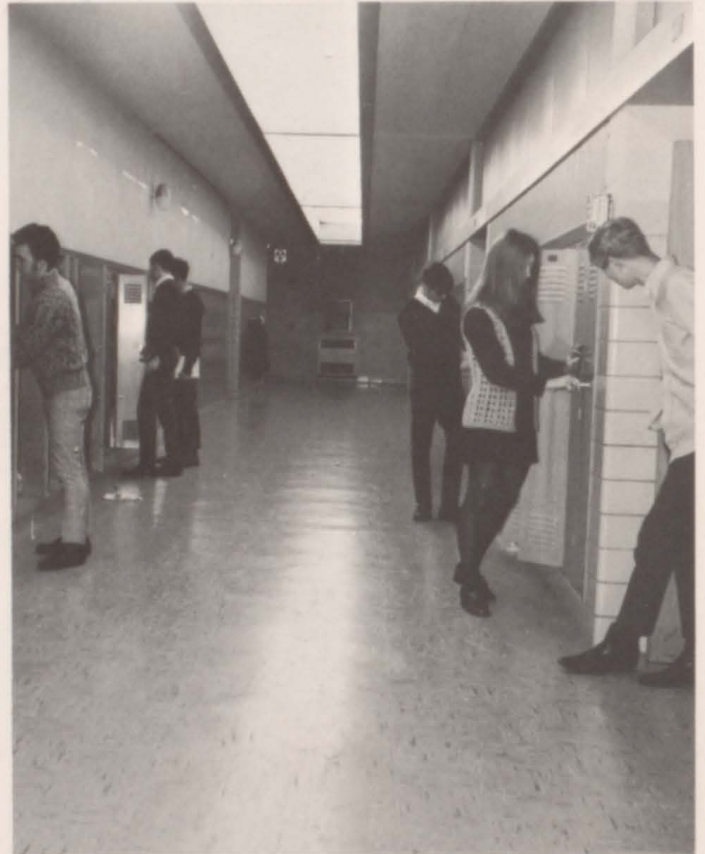

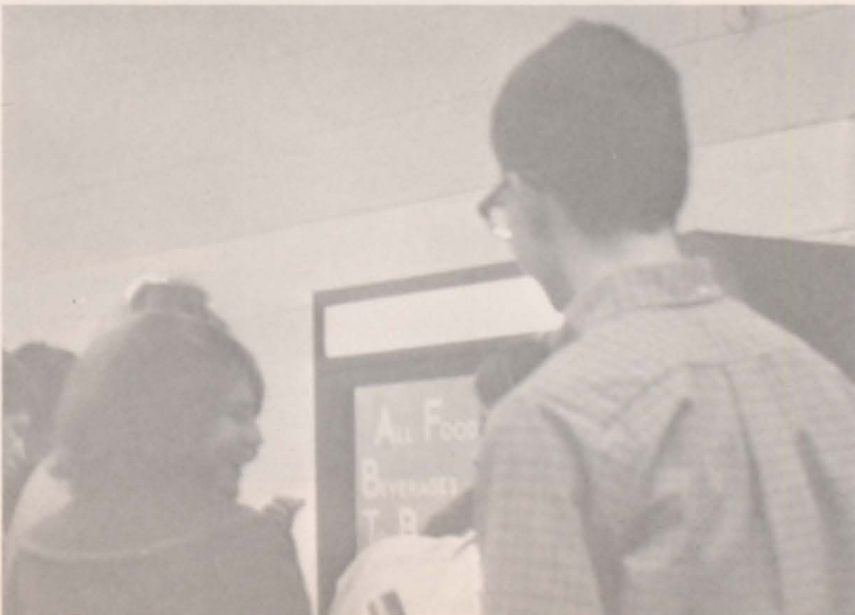
### STUDENT COUNCIL

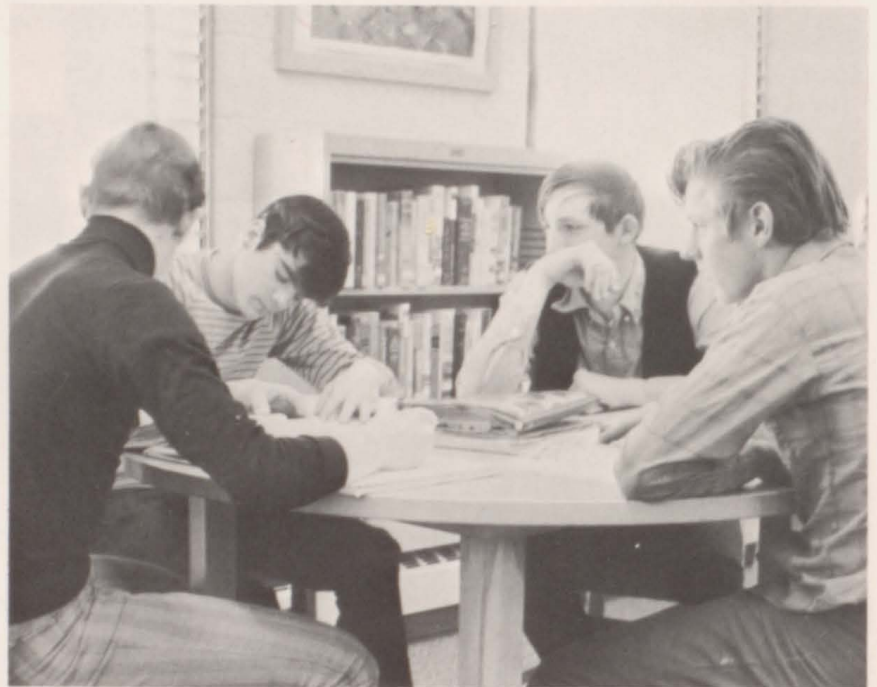

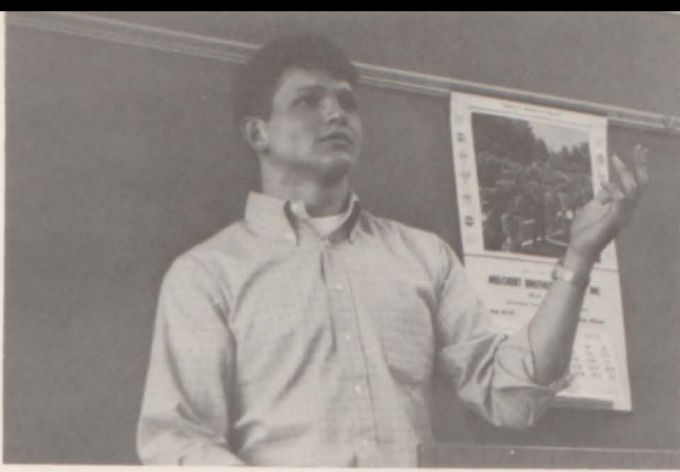


#### DEBATE

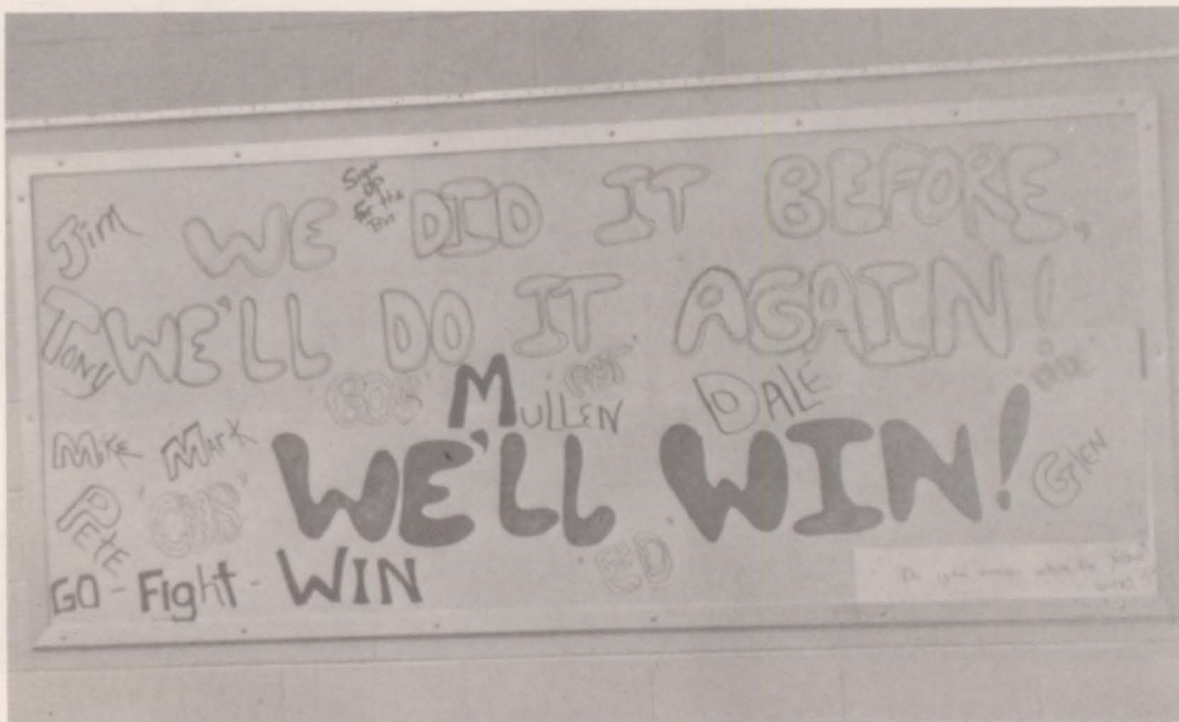

Tournament opponents this year were Green Bay East and Preble. Both of these teams were given excellent competition by Seymour.

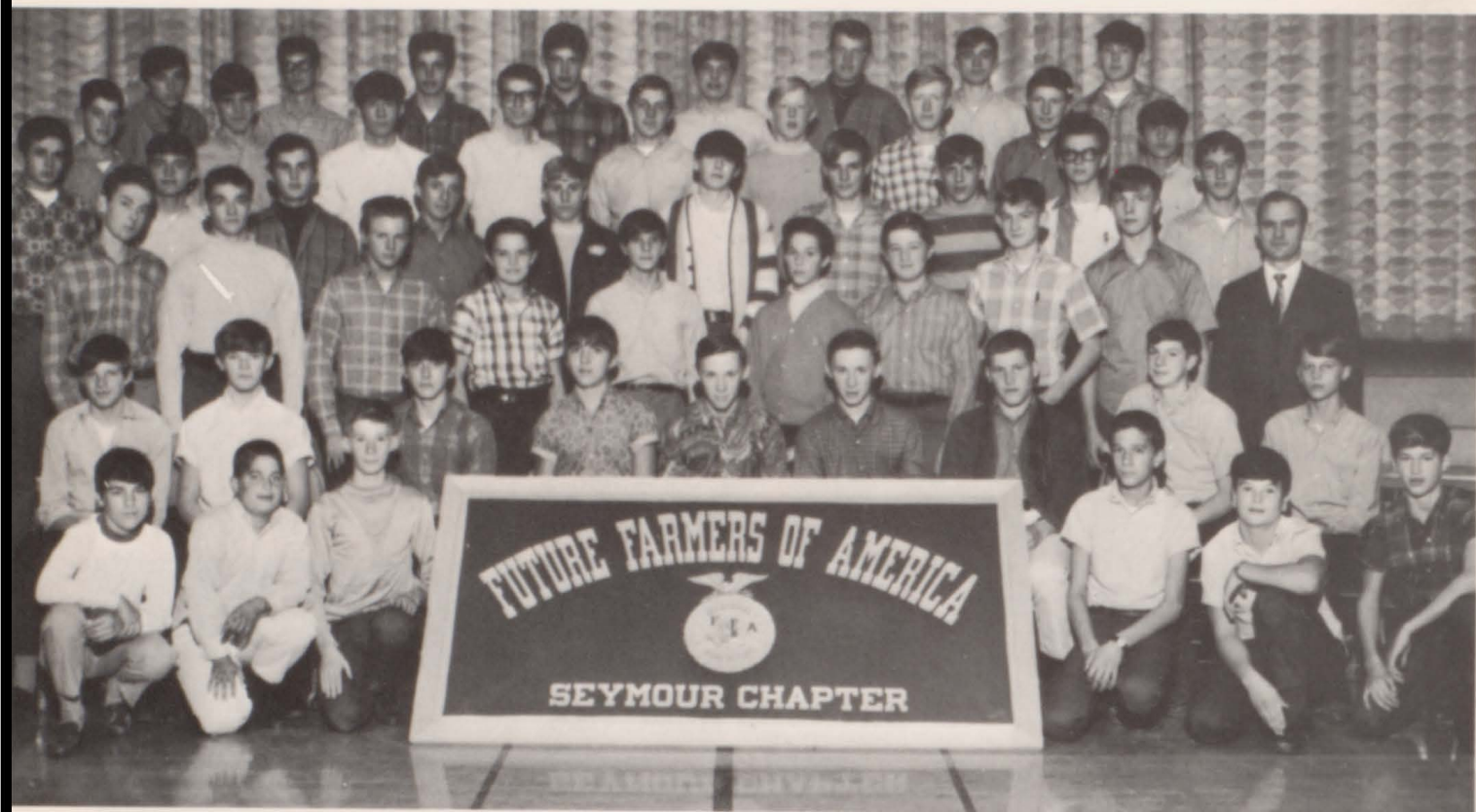
