## **Act III / Antony's Funeral Speech**

READ all of the questions CAREFULLY / write NEATLY / Proof

1. VOCAB TIP: **interred** means buried

OfT is short for often

**IN YOUR OWN words** (not the words Shakespeare used) WITHOUT looking it up, paraphrase this passage:

"The evil that men do lives after them;  
The good is oft interred with their bones"

2. On the bottom half of page one Antony lists TWO good things Caesar did. LIST them IN YOUR OWN words – do NOT use Shakespeare's words
3. On the top of page two Antony provides evidence that Caesar was NOT too ambitious when he says Ceasar.... (put it in YOUR OWN words / modern English)
4. In your OWN words explain the question that Antony asks the crowd. Why....

5. Antony STOPS his speech for awhile because... (explain in your OWN words)
  
6. In the bottom ½ of page two Antony says he doesn't want to cause the crowd to... or it would dishonor Brutus and Cassius. What does he CLAIM he doesn't want to do? (note he really is trying to do this but he needs to be sneaky and strategic in how he goes about doing this)
  
7. What is Antony going to read to the people? What purpose might that serve?

NOTE: If you were able to see more of the play, you will see that many of the people end up agreeing w/ Antony and Brutus and Cassius quickly leave the area.
