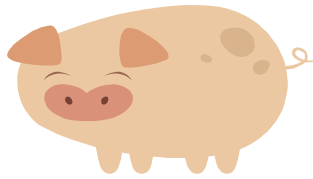

<p><b><u>ORGANIZATION</u></b></p> <p><b>INTRO</b> –Less than 3 sent</p> <p>Does not give overview of the story to set the scene</p> <p>Lacks a catch attention</p> <p>Lacks clear, direct claim/ thesis statement</p> <p>Says “this paper will be about” etc.</p>	<p><b><u>ORGANIZATION</u></b></p> <p><b>INTRO</b> – Simplistic catch attention – uses a ? to catch attention or not creative</p> <p>Overview of story brief</p> <p>Claim / Thesis statement clear but says “this paper is about</p>	<p><b><u>ORGANIZATION</u></b></p> <p><b>INTRO</b> -<u>3 sent min</u></p> <p>Catch attention, give an overview of the story, and state claim or thesis. ***<b><u>BOLD CLAIM</u></b>***</p> <p>Preview paper WITHOUT saying “this paper will be about.” Ideally catch attention WITHOUT using a question</p>

<p><b>BODY&amp; IDEAS -</b> Missing general topic sentence</p> <p>Lacking direct quotes or use simplistic quotes like mottos (“Napoleon is always right” or “I will work harder”)</p> <p>Missing or incorrect ( ) citations</p> <p>Body paragraph less than 6 sent</p> <p>Lacks specific, meaningful textual support</p> <p><b>CONCLUSION –</b></p> <p>Introduces new info and /or does not restate main points</p> <p>Less than 3 sent.</p>	<p><b>BODY &amp; IDEAS –</b> Topic sentence is short, choppy, and simplistic</p> <p>Three MEANINGFUL exact quotes – NOT mottos or commandments</p> <p>correct ( ) citations that support the claim</p> <p>Set up quotes and follow up w/ commentary analysis</p> <p>Focused on claim / not retelling the story</p> <p><b>CONCLUSION –</b></p> <p>Restates main points without introducing new info but does not do it in a memorable, creative way</p> <p>3 or more sent</p>	<p><b>BODY &amp; IDEAS –</b> Interesting general topic sentence before going into specifics – Transition if there’s more than 1 body paragraph</p> <p><b>*** BOLD TOPIC SENTENCE***</b></p> <p>Set up / intro MORE than three <u>meaningful</u> quotes supporting your claim w/ proper ( ) / not mottos or commandments</p> <p>Thorough, insightful commentary explaining the significance of the quotes</p> <p>Focused on claim and does NOT retell story</p> <p><b>CONCLUSION –</b></p> <p>Restates main points without introducing new info and does so in a memorable and creative</p> <p>3 or more sent</p>
<p><b>MECHANICS AND ACADEMIC TONE –</b></p> <p>Capitalization, punctuation errors, fragments, run ons, etc.</p> <p>Personal references / Uses you, your, etc.</p>	<p><b><u>MECHANICS AND ACADEMIC TONE –</u></b> Formal academic tone (no personal references or use of you/ your)</p> <p>No fragments or run ons – minimal minor errors</p>	<p><b><u>MECHANICS AND ACADEMIC TONE –</u></b></p> <p>Formal Academic Tone – no personal references, no use of you/ your</p> <p>No mechanical errors of any kind</p>

REMINDERS:

- Use three examples needs to be a **MEANINGFUL** quote from the book **NOT** just a motto or commandments that are repeated
- Use proper citations when citing passages –with the period AFTER the ( ) – Ex. “Major died peacefully in his sleep” (Orwell 35).
- **UNDERLINE A COMPLEX SENTENCE THAT STARTS W/ A SUBORDINATING CONJUNCTION (i.e. because, although, even though, since, etc.)**
- **BOLD** your CLAIM statement in your INTRO and TOPIC sentences

## Writing Options – Your paper will be about ONE of these options

Read over the following controversial issues from *Animal Farm*. In your essay argue for OR against ONE of statements that are listed. (In other words, you may agree or disagree with the statement.) Use specifics from the story to support your position.

Take a CLEAR, DIRECT, CONSISTENT stand  
Do not show the pros and cons of the issue

1. Boxer is the most important animal on the farm.
2. The characters in the book demonstrate Orwell's belief that absolute power corrupts absolutely. Show how the power corrupted Napoleon and Squealer.
3. Explain w/ evidence from the book who would have been a better leader (Boxer, the dogs, Squealer, Snowball, Benjamin, etc.—SELECT ONE AND ONLY ONE) than Napoleon.
4. Animal Farm teaches important lessons. Select three themes from the book and provide specific textual support to back up each theme.
5. Additional Option for Eng 10 Only. Life was harder under the pigs leadership than under Mr. Jones' leadership.

**Did you underline your complex sent that STARTS w/ a sub conj? (Because, since, although, even though, etc.)**

**Bold your claim and your topic sentences too!**

- 10% off if you can PROVE it was done on time and you just forgot to hit TURN IN
