

Highlighted EXPECTATIONS:

- Carefully follow the rubric to ensure you are maximizing your points.
- Let's clarify key expectations and AVOID common mistakes 😊

CHECK for Understanding:

Do you write a PRO / CON presentation

Or

Are you making a CLEAR, CONSISTANT
STAND?

ANSWER:

- A CLEAR, CONSISTENT STAND ARGUING WITH SPECIFIC EVIDENCE FROM YOUR RESEARCH – NOT JUST YOUR OPINION
- AVOID personal references
- You need to have info on the **OTHER** side so you can **OVERCOME** the Objections

Check for Understanding

- ⦿ **How do you overcome objections?**

Answer:

- ◎ We do practice activities on this but see rubric for sample sentence **starters** like:
 - > Although critics warn that ...
 - > Even though opponents believe...

Use the starters listed above or on your rubric and address the specific objection listed with **RESEARCH (facts, stats, specifics- NOT just your opinion)**. Remember this is a **RESEARCH UNIT**

Check for Understanding

How many times do you turn in your Works Cited Sheet?

ANSWER:

TWICE:

- Once at the beginning of the unit and **AGAIN** at the **BOTTOM** of the paper when the project is due with any needed corrections and/or additions

Check for Understanding:

What information needs to be cited?

ANSWER:

- ALL information that is not commonly known – EVEN PARAPHRASED info NEEDS to be cited – NOT just quotes!
- **EVERY body** paragraph needs () citations that site sources
- A citation can refer back up through the paragraph but NOT beyond the paragraph

Check for Understanding:

- ◉ What goes inside the () citation?
- ◉ Whatever comes **FIRST** in the Works Cited Sheet is what goes in the ()
- ◉ We will practice this in class AND I will provide you a sample paper to refer to.

Check for Understanding

- ⦿ **What sentence needs to be underlined?**

Check for Understanding:

- A COMPLEX Sentence that STARTS with a SUBORDINATING CONJUNCTION (although, because, even though, since

EXAMPLE:

- Even though the minimum wage is higher than it was years ago, it has not kept up with inflation.
