



Sticky Notes

For this assignment, **each chapter** you read must contain a minimum of **4 sticky notes**. You must include one of each of the following:

Question: on one sticky note record one question you have about the text. This cannot be a factual question like, “What is Maya’s brother’s name?” Your question sticky must be a question you are unsure of about the text or something you are wondering about as your read.

Connection: as you read you must use one sticky to record a connection you have with the text. This cannot be something as simple as, “Maya likes pineapple and I like pineapple too”. Your connection makes a deeper meaning between you and the text. Maybe you have been in a similar situation or felt similar to how Maya feels at a certain point in your reading.

Interest: one sticky must include something you found interesting during your reading. This could include a specific quote from a character or a specific event in the book. You must include why this sticky is interesting to you.

Inference: making inferences (or predictions) as you read will help you better understand the text. For this sticky, make one inference about what you think will happen later in the novel. This should not be something you find out in the next couple paragraphs, but rather something you may not find out for another few chapters/pages. Be sure to include the evidence that makes you think believe that inference.
