- 2. Do you think Snowball really did all of the things he was accused of doing? Provide textual support for your opinion. Can you find the story they told about the key and Snowball in chapter 7? What ADDITIONAL things was he blamed for that he shouldn't have been?
- 3. The hens AND other animals "admit" to countless crimes. Re-read that section. Do you really think they did all of the things he said he did? What things do they confess to that makes you think that at least some of their confessions are false? (chapter 7)
- 4. What happened to the windmill the first time it was destroyed? How do we know the pigs don't even believe themselves their own explanation? (chapter 7)
- 5. What has been really happening to the commandments that have been written on the side of the barn? How do we know this? Were the animals really remembering them wrong? (chapter 8)
- 6. What caused Napoleon to get so sick? How do you know this? Provide MULTIPLE forms of evidence. At first it seems like Napoleon learned his lesson from his experience and then we have reason to believe that his sickness will not change his habits. Explain how we know this. (chapter 8)
