



Early College Credit & Start College Now Programs

Early College Credit allows high school students to take one or more courses at an institution of higher education for high school and/or college credit. "Institution of higher education" includes University of Wisconsin colleges, tribally controlled colleges, or a private, nonprofit institution of higher education located in Wisconsin.

Start College Now allows students who have completed 10th grade to have the option to take courses at a Fox Valley Technical College.

Who is eligible?

Students who have met with their high school counselor, meet the entrance criteria and are in good standing. Each college may have additional entrance requirements.

Deadlines

Students must submit the application to their school counselor by **February 1** for the summer term (only available for ECCP), **March 1** for the fall semester and **October 1** for the spring semester.

Cost

The Seymour Community School district will pay for tuition, course fees and textbooks. If **a course is dropped or failed** by the student or their parent/guardian, the parent/guardian assumes all associated costs. The district will not pay for any consumables or supplies (ie uniforms, stethoscope, tools). If a student fails a course, the district will not pay for any future courses.

Books

The district will pay for required textbooks we don't already own. Before purchasing books, the student must check for the book in the high school LMC (library). If a book is not available, the student must follow the college's procedure to charge the books to the high school. These books must be returned to the LMC upon completion of the course.

How many classes can I take?

The district will pay for up to 18 total non-comparable college credits. The district will not pay for classes that are offered at the high school.

May students take courses through SCN and ECCP (Early College Credit Program through the UW System) at the same time? No.

Transportation

The student is responsible for any transportation costs to attend courses held at the college campus or other location.

Student Responsibilities:

1. Meet with your high school counselor
2. Fill out the application located on the college's website and return to the high school Student Services office before the deadline.
(The Student Services Office will send the form to the college with the student's transcript.)
3. Watch for an email from the college
4. Follow their directions on how to enroll in courses. Pay close attention to deadlines. Contact the college if you need help.
5. Work with your school counselor to see if a course selected will fit into your high school schedule
