## Seymour Community High School School Supplies and Course Fee Information

Due to supply needs varying based on the courses your student(s) will be taking, SCHS has put together a list of the most commonly used items for a variety of courses. Teachers will inform students of a specific supply/supplies they will need on the first day of school.

**Backpacks**-A recommendation from the Wisconsin School Safety Coordinators Association, who con ducted a safety assessment, was to institute a rule that backpacks are required to be kept in lockers during the school day. However, students will be allowed to carry a pencil/pen case throughout the day. This case should not exceed 11" x 6". If a student is injured and needs the convenience of a backpack, please contact Student Services.

## **Suggested SCHS supplies:**

- Single subject wire notebooks and folders for each class
- Notecards
- 3-ring binders (preferably binders without zippers)
- Pens, pencils, colored pencils and/or markers
- Pencil/pen case, not to exceed 11" x 6"
- Safety glasses for technology and/or jewelry classes
- Sketchbook for all art classes
- Package of highlighters
- Wired ear buds (cheaper, Dollar Store ones are sufficient)
- Phy Ed-students may want to purchase separate shorts, shirt and/or gym shoes. Locks (optional) are also available for purchase in the HS Main Office.

College Credit Precalculus and College Credit Calculus students should purchase one of the following graphing calculators by Texas Instruments:

- TI-84 Plus C Silver Edition (this is a color model with TI rechargeable battery)
- TI-84 Plus Silver Edition
- TI-84 Plus

(Students would be at a disadvantage with a TI-83 model. Certain models, such as TI-89 or any other model containing CAS will **not** be allowed)

## **Course Fees**

College credit and many of our project-based courses have a course fee. These fees (excluding college credit) are reviewed annually and determined based on the cost of consumable materials. These fees are charged to students who choose to take these courses.
